J	Summer Session	K - 5th	Monday - Friday, 9:00am-12:30pm the last two weeks in June at OLL	Students must attend every day of the two weeks to receive credit for the school year. While Summer Session takes the place of school year catechesis, additional attendance at Family Faith Gatherings is encouraged to help keep the family connected to the parish year round.
S	Catechesis of the Good Shepherd	3 yr - 1st	Sunday, 5-6:30pm	Montessori based faith formation with a hands-on approach which allows students the opportunity to experience religious values while celebrating their uniquely childlike enthusiastic enjoyment of God. Students must be 3 by September 1 & be completely toilet trained. Due to limited space in the Atria, preference for spots in the Wednesday classes will be given to older children who have attended Catechesis of the Good Shepherd in previous years.

T	Catechesis of the Good Shepherd	3yr-PreK	Thursday Morning, 9:45 - 11:30am	
E	Elementary	K - 5th	Wednesday Evening, 6:30-7:45pm	K-1st will be in Catechesis of the Good Shepherd, 2nd-5th will be in traditional religious education classes with sacrament prep for Reconciliation and First Communion.
M	Crossover	6th & 7th	Sunday, 5 - 6:30pm	Crossover is a combination of large group learning, small group interaction, activities, and prayer. Developmentally appropriate social activities help to keep young teens connected.
C	Confirmation	8th	Sunday, 5 - 6:30pm	Students will be prepared both intellectually and spiritually to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation and to become lifelong disciples of Christ.
L	Life Teen	High School	Sunday, 7 - 8:30pm	Life Teen includes games, catechesis, small groups, Bible study and prayer. The nights focus on a range of catechetical topics and social issues, and includes nights of worship and social activities, both on & off site, to promote growth in relationship with other young Catholics.
F	Family Faith Gatherings	All ages	Saturday after Mass, 1st weekend each month, October - March	Family Faith Gatherings (FFG) will be a way for families to come together once a month during the school year for faith renewal and fellowship. \$75 per family covers all 6 sessions and will include a meal, faith building activities and breakout sessions for all age groups. Retreats to help families prepare for the seasons of Advent and Lent will be included in this program. List names (and age/grade of children) of all participants.
